


SHANNON EXPLAINS THE NAME CHANGE

I have been in care for 9 years and from the age of 8 I have been a part of the Young Lives Foundation (YLF) and moved from a junior member to a senior member. During this time I have experienced so many new things such as go karting and residential trips to Wales. I even carried the Magna Carta at Rochester Cathedral worth millions of pounds - and I didn't even drop it!

The groups have allowed me to meet new people, grow more confident in everything I do and learn new skills. Whilst being a part of YLF, I have attended meetings with the MCYPC (Medway's Children and Young People Council) where we discuss many topics such as Stigma, our rights and improving life in care.

One of the things I am proudest of being involved in is how children in care are viewed, and challenging stigma and negative views. So we changed our old name, Children in Care Council, to Medway's Children and Young People Council (MCYPC) as people like me did not want to be labelled as children in care. I feel like this was a positive move and I hope it makes us all feel equal and the same as any other children in or out of the system.
