Our Volunteering Roles

Befriending - an Independent Visitor who meets, advises and befriends a young person in care, taking a long-term interest in their well-being and development.

Mentoring - a positive role model, who is there to guide and advise, striving to meet set goals to help young people achieve their potential.

Accompanying Adult - when unaccompanied children in the immigration system have their age disputed, an Accompanying Adult acts independently to ensure their age assessments are conducted properly and fairly.

Appropriate Adult - acts independently from the police to ensure that all processes necessary are conducted fairly and properly whilst a detained person is in custody.
